



Introducing The Story of Soil

We first heard about these wines a few years ago. A customer was shopping with us and asked this question in a reverend hush: "Have you heard of the winery Story of Soil?". We shook our heads, our client put her hands to her cheeks and whispered, "You HAVE to try their wines!"

Fast forward to last Monday when we attended an Industry Tasting at the University Club which included Jessica Gasca's Story of Soil wines. Well, to put it bluntly, we were astounded. The balance, finesse, the savoir-faire that flowed from her bottles; it was like finishing the perfect blind date anticipating more great dates to come.

Today three of her creations arrived on our doorstep; all single vineyard bottlings that hold a sense of place from where they were grown. Please read and enjoy.

2021 Story of Soil Pinot Noir Rosé Gold Coast Vineyard (Santa Maria Valley) \$30

First impressions: Clementine orange, citrus, and white flowers. On the palate a beautiful array of tangerine, citrus zest, and salinity. This is a snazzy Rose that has great texture, zippy acidity, and lots of verve.

2021 Story of Soil Sauvignon Blanc Grassini Vineyard (Happy Canyon of Santa Barbara) \$38

The next wine takes us to Happy Canyon and the Grassini Vineyard. A plush Sauv Blanc with yellow citrus notes mingling with rocks and a creamy punch in the mid-palate. Reminds us favorably of really good white Bordeaux. Fantastic job here.

2021 Story of Soil Gamay Noir Martian Vineyard (Santa Barbara County) \$42

Our third wine is from the biodynamically farmed Martian Vineyard and may be one of our favorite local reds of the last few months. This oozed classic Beaujolais Gamay. Spicy, savory, worthy. We kept going back, taste after taste, until not surprisingly we had finished the bottle.

Swing by and pick up a few bottles for the weekend and prepare to be amazed. Any three bottles gets you a 10% discount too.
